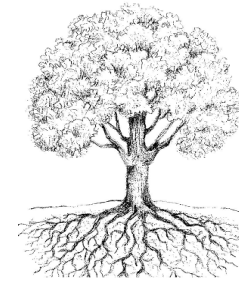

NEWS FROM THE ENDOWMENT TEAM

The Endowment Team would like to say a huge “Thank You” to all Salem members and friends for their support and contributions to the Educational Scholarship and Endowment Legacy Funds in 2021.

EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Thanks to your generosity over \$3480 was raised through direct contributions and bread bake fundraisers for the Salem Educational Scholarship Fund this past year.

Additional funding this past year was appropriated by the Servant Leadership Council. A \$500 gift was received from the Salem Women's Group and \$1185 was given to this fund by the Salem Centennial Anniversary Team from money not used in their account.

The Endowment Team also “Thanks” the SLC, Salem Women’s Group, the Centennial Anniversary Team, and the Salem Bread Ministry Team for their support. Due to the funds received the Endowment Team was able to distribute (5) \$500 scholarship grants totaling \$2500 to well qualified students in 2021. The Salem Educational Scholarship Fund is also in a good position for the Team to issue scholarship grants again in 2022.

ENDOWMENT LEGACY FUND: Again, thanks to your generosity over \$8760 was contributed to the Endowment Legacy Fund in 2021. In addition to the contributions received, \$3,443.50 was transferred from the LUG (Large Undesignated Gift) money to the Endowment Legacy Fund. This brings the total amount in the Endowment Legacy Fund to over \$57,570. The Endowment Team is very Thankful for the growth of this fund.

To help continue the growth of these funds in 2022 your contributions and generosity are very much appreciated.
