MARCH FOOD SHARE CAMPAIGN

February 27 - April 9th, 2023 We are asking congregations in our area to join us in the effort to support our local food shelf and meet our goal of raising \$75,00 during this year's fundraiser.

In 2022 we fed 230 families consisting of 896 total people (unduplicated numbers). We had an overall increase in food shelf usage of 76% from 2021. Due to inflation and rising prices, many families found themselves in need of help with basic necessities. Food prices are expected to grow another 7.1% in 2023. This is less than last year, but still above historical rates. Your support will ensure that we can continue to provide food and other assistance to those in need. As always, 100% of the donated money is used to benefit Food Shelf Clients and shoppers.
