
Memorial Gift Wish List

Salem Financial Update

We currently have a positive dollar amount in the General Fund; however, this is due to the congregation's vote at the 2024 Annual Meeting to utilize \$17,000.00 from LUG 8.29.22. The motion was to use these funds to make up for months or times when our General Fund giving did not meet our expenses. Without the utilization of these monies, our General Fund would be -\$9,067.16. All unnecessary spending from the General Fund has

been frozen since 2021. We have done office supply and cleaning, toilet paper type drives in order to keep costs down, but the reality of the situation indicates that our General Fund giving is just not enough to meet our bills. Prices of just about everything has gone up and we recognize we are all a bit anxious about finances whether at work, church or in our homes. so we want you to know how grateful we are for every dollar we receive to keep doing the ministry through Salem God has called us to do and we will continue to look for creative and thrifty ways to stretch your dollars as far as possible.

There are however, a couple areas we already anticipate our 2025 budgeted General Fund line item amounts will be insufficient. These include our property insurance, electricity, propane, and new accounting software (QuickBooks). We are doing everything we can to cutback, make do, and trust in God's abundant giving, but we need your help. If current giving does not increase, what is left of the \$17,000 cushion will not last the year. Please prayerfully consider an increase in your General Fund giving. Big gifts or small all matter and are greatly appreciated. Salem is not Pastor Trish's church, nor the council, nor any one family's but is God's church. We are God's caretakers of Salem and an important presence for so many in our community and the world.
