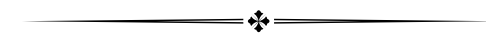

Taylor's Confirmation Bible Verse is 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a

Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends.

Taylor's Faith Statement

My understanding of God is that God always loves us, is always with us, and I know that God is always going to forgive us no matter what. I talk to God when I am hurting or am having an emotional day because God calms me. Like on Wednesdays, when I am having a bad day I always come to confirmation and seeing the other youth and pastor Trish, and even meanie Mitch, somehow helps to make the rest of my day better. On bad days though, I do question why God lets things happen, why I am having a bad day, or what did I do to have the things that happen to me happen.

I have come to understand God this way through different people in my life. One of the people that has helped me is pastor Trish. Pastor Trish has helped me understand God by telling stories from the bible and her personal stories of her life and God. My friends have also helped me understand God. A friend, I'm not friends with anymore. helped me be excited to go to confirmation and church, and helped me learn more about God. When I moved schools, my new friends also helped me understand God more because they helped me feel accepted and that helps me feel accepted by God. But there are also times that adults or my friends can make me feel bad about myself and it makes me wonder if God is really there.

I want my relationship with God to grow more, and I am curious about everything about God, and especially why people are the way that they are. Why are people in the world sometimes mean? Why is there so much hate in the world? I would like to know how we can fix the hate and how God can help to fix the hate in the world. When I think of being curious about things, I think of Curious George and how even though he got in a little bit of trouble at times, he still wasn't afraid to explore and do things that he was scared of. Understanding that God is always with me helps me be more comfortable and step out of my comfort zone to do new things and be more like Curious George. I know that even if I do get in a little bit of trouble God will always forgive me.

I want others in the world to know that God loves them, and that God is always with them. When people make bad decisions, I don't believe that they do it because they are happy to do it. I think that they make bad decisions because they had something in their life happen that made them feel bad about themselves. So, I think that if they knew that God loved them, no matter what, then maybe they would make better decisions. I think that we could show people God loves them by showing that we love them like the people in my life have helped me to know God.
